Rental Property

The AHCA has to occasionally address questions and concerns regarding rental properties within the neighborhood. There are currently 43 Academy Heights' homes that are officially registered with Baltimore County as rental properties. Homeowners, landlords and tenants should be aware of the following...

Baltimore County Code Section 35-5-201 requires that if you own a property in Academy Heights that that you intend to rent, it must be registered and licensed, or approved for exemption, by Baltimore County before tenants move into the property. Unless otherwise exempted, the law applies to all rentals, including Short-term Rentals advertised on such sites as AirBnB or VRBO. This does not include dwelling units solely occupied by a person related by blood, marriage, or adoption to or under the legal custody of the owner of the unit, which may include one additional individual who is not a minor without regard to the relationship of the individual and without regard to the number of minors in the dwelling unit related by blood, marriage or adoption to the additional individual or under the legal custody of the owner. Individuals must be related as grandparents, parents, children, or grandchildren only. The purpose of the law is to help enforce the County's codes and regulations that protect and promote public safety, health and welfare.

The property must have a rental inspection and the license is valid for three years. A person who owns and rents a dwelling unit or a portion of a dwelling unit without a license may be subject to the denial, suspension, revocation of the license or civil penalties of \$25 per day for each day a violation occurs and \$200 per day for each day a correction notice is not complied with, and there will be a \$1,000 fine for not complying with the Rental Registration Law. If you are concerned that a rental property is not registered with the County, call 410-887-6060. If the property is not registered, you may enter a complaint (anonymously if you wish) and a letter will be sent to the property owner requesting specific information. The owner will have 30 days to comply.

Our Alleyways

Alley parking can be dangerous if there is not enough space for emergency vehicles to pass through. The Baltimore County Code, Article 18, Title two, Sub-title 202 states that "(b) A person may not park, stop, or leave unattended a vehicle in any alley leaving less than 12 feet of clearance parallel to the vehicle."

In addition, vehicles blocking alleys can prevent access for trash and recycling collection trucks, utility and work trucks. Vehicles that block alleys are subject to ticketing and towing. To report a blocked alley, call the police at **410-887-2222**.

PARKING ETIQUETTE REMINDER

Academy Heights has a limited number of parking spaces. We are unable to paint lines, assign spaces, do angled parking, etc.....so we need to show some respect and park wisely.

Residents should be able to park one car in front (or near) their home. Multi-car residents should be using the alleys, parking in areas not in front of homes (Northdale, open sides of Whitfield or Northdale, end of street) or a parking pad.

A vehicle not being used for some extended time should also be parked elsewhere and not take up a space on your block or in front of a neighbor. Residents should be aware of spacing when parking their vehicles, so that we are maximizing the space available. Obviously, it is difficult to control guest and work vehicle parking.

Yes, these are public streets and the parking situation will always be a challenge.

We just ask that all residents be courteous and respectful of their neighbors when parking vehicles.
